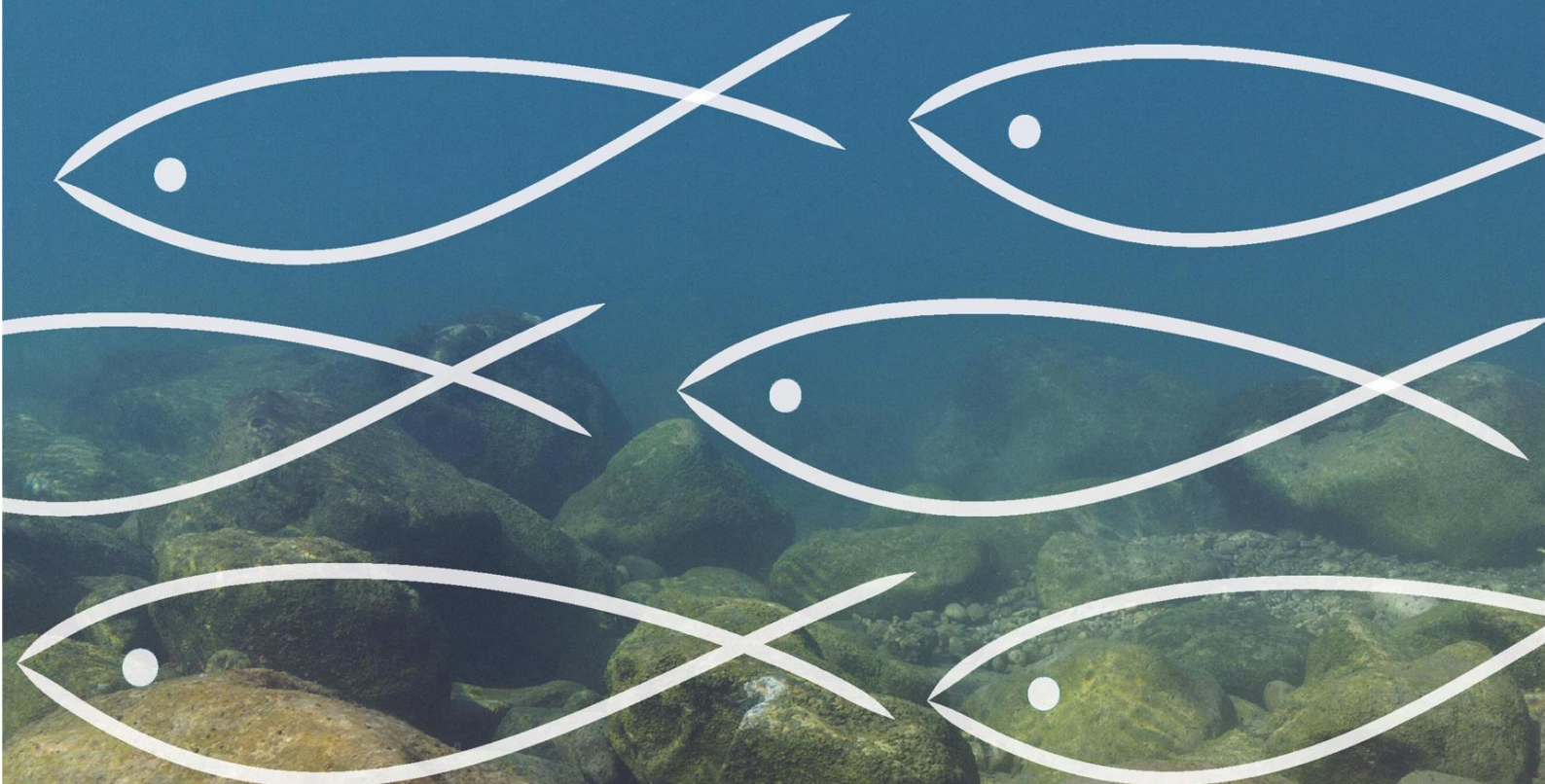

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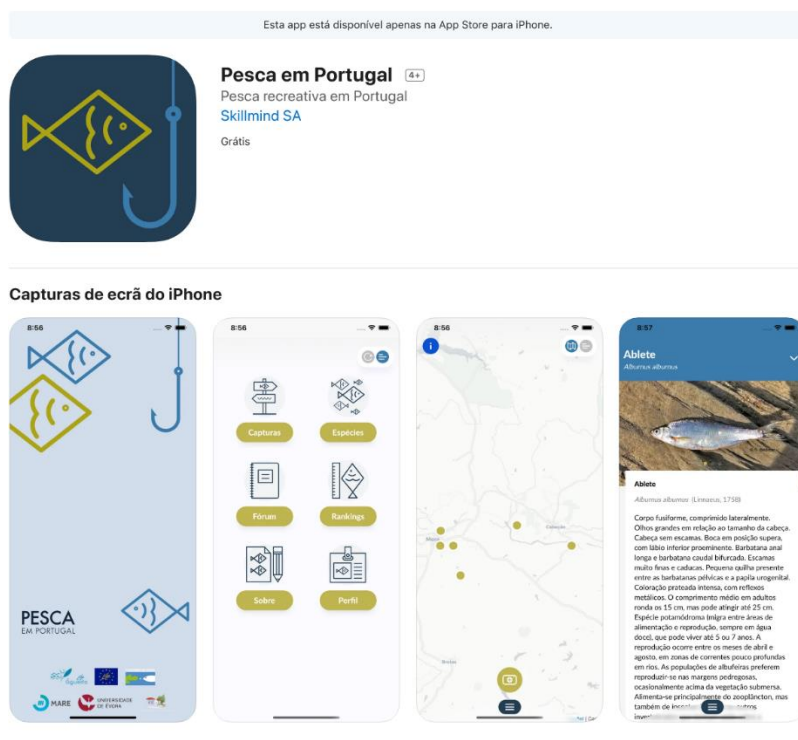


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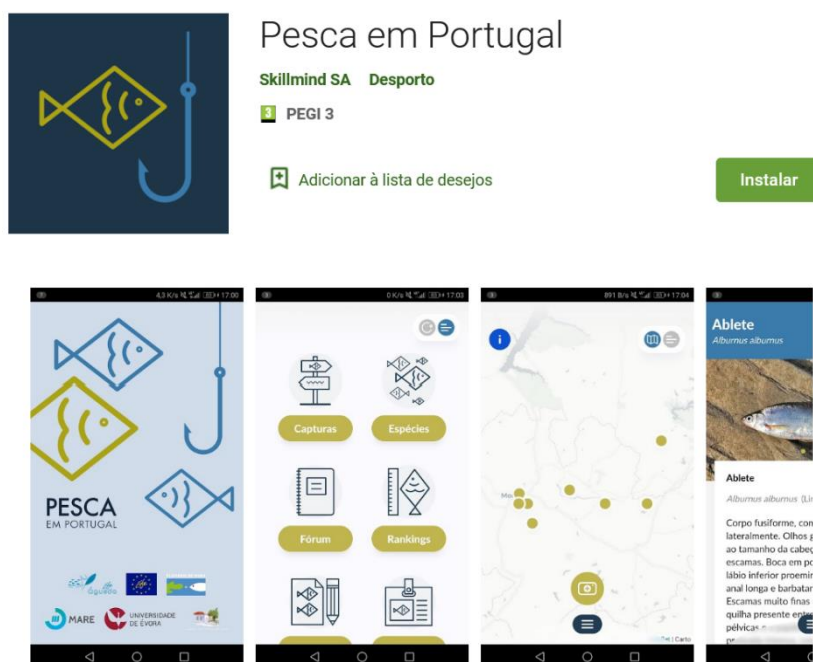
1. SETUP

Download the app for iOS (App Store¹) or Android (Google Play²):

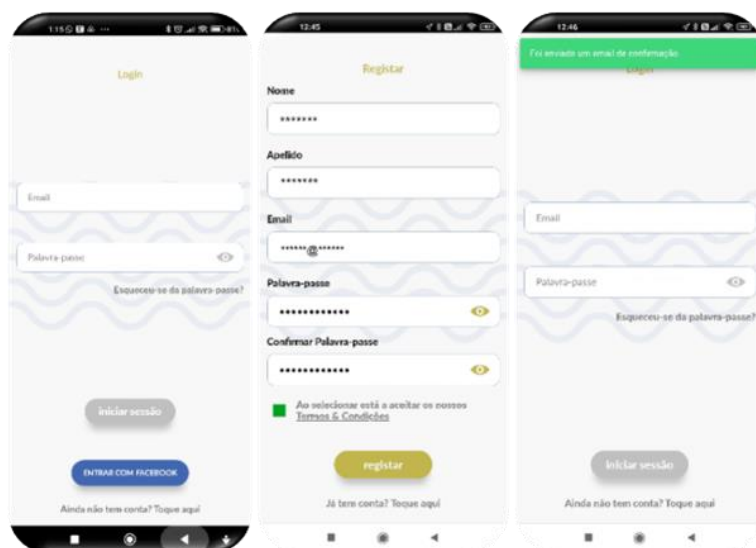

Launch the application and follow the steps to register a new account or log in if you have already created an account.

2. New Register

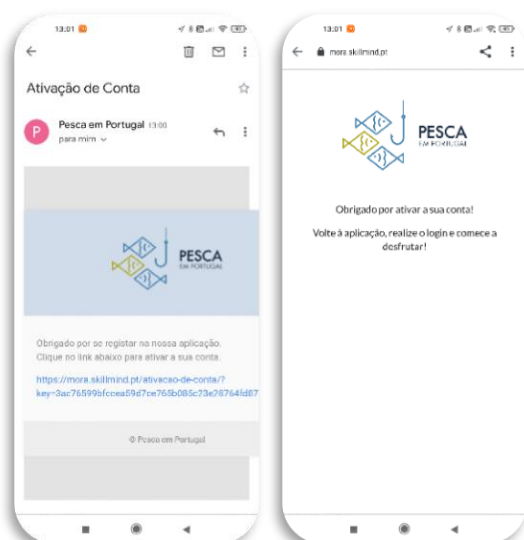


To register with an email, select the option marked with the solid arrow in the first image and fill in the fields with the requested data (next image).

When you select the "register" option, you will be prompted to send an email to the registered address (image on the right).

Alternatively, you can register

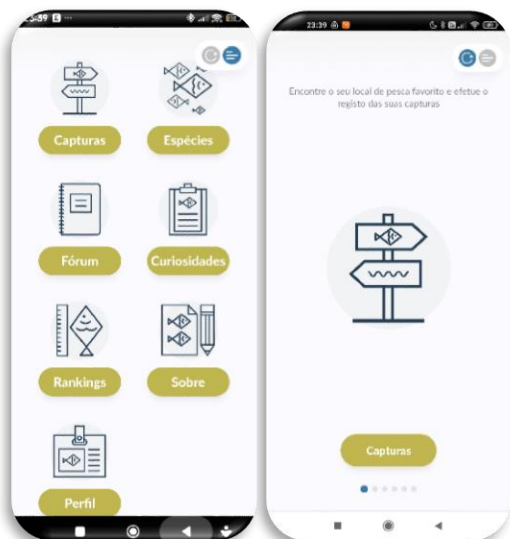
using your Facebook account (dashed arrow).



Click on the link in your email to activate your account. You will then receive a confirmation message.

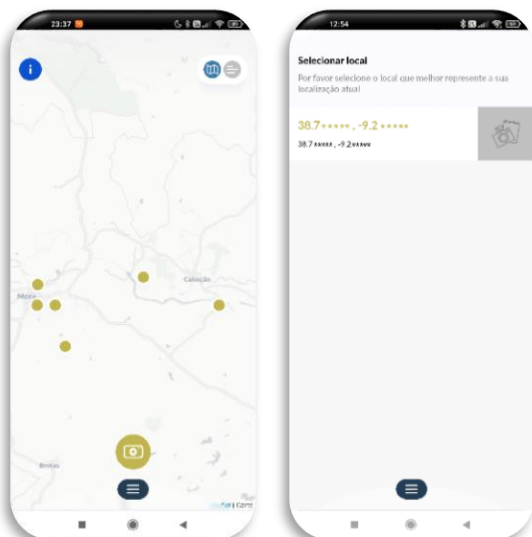
You can now start using your new "Pesca em Portugal" ("Fishing in Portugal") application.

3. Using the Fishing in Portugal application



You can choose the view of all the menus on the screen -   - or switch to a circular view -  .

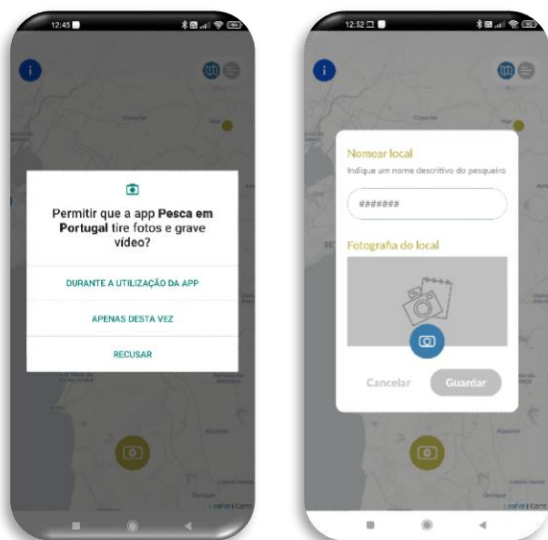
3.1. Catches



In this menu you can enter your catches, view and register fishing spots.

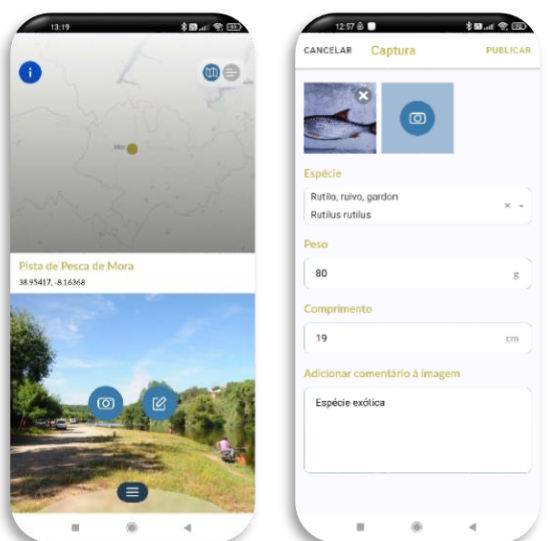
Para inserir uma captura, selecione o ícone da câmara  ao fundo do ecrã.

Caso se encontre perto de um pesqueiro já registado, ser-lhe-á apresentada uma lista de pesqueiros (num raio de 300 m) para seleccionar o local em que se encontra. Esta função implica a autorização da aplicação à localização do dispositivo.



De forma a poder registar um local e uma captura, terá de conceder à Aplicação o acesso à Câmara.

Todos os registos e edições de pesqueiros serão alvo de aprovação pelos gestores da aplicação.



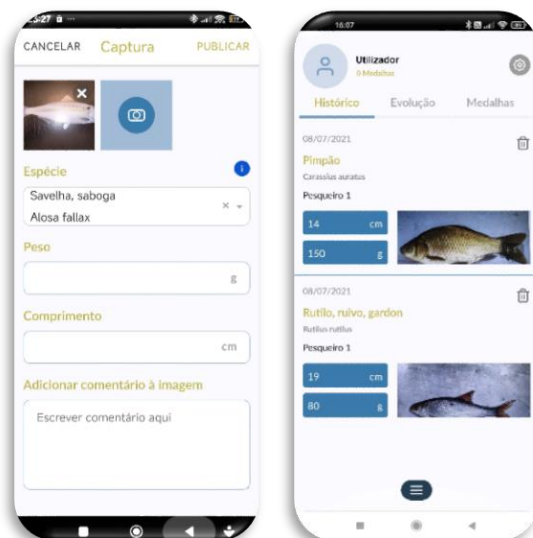
You can also select a fishing spot and immediately insert a catch into it by selecting the Camera icon,  (if you want to insert a capture at another time, this is the method you should use). To edit a fishing ground you have created, click on the edit icon, .

When you register a new catch, you will be asked to upload one (mandatory) or more photos of the specimen you have caught. Once you have saved the photo(s), you can choose the species you have

captured from the available list.

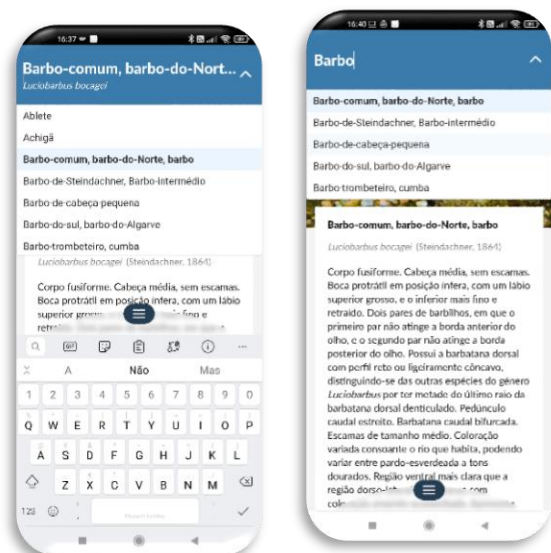
To consult the species library, use the information button to the right of the list (). If you still cannot identify the species, select 'Unidentifiable'. Our team will be able to identify it later, depending on the quality of the images provided.

You must record the weight and length of the specimen caught at the time of registration, and you can add comments in the box provided for this purpose. To save, select 'Publish'. It will not be possible to edit the values recorded after selecting 'Publish'.



All catches recorded are subject to verification. Once your catch has been validated, it will appear in your Profile and will be published in the Rankings list.

3.2. Species



In this menu you can access a list of all the freshwater and migratory species that occur in mainland Portugal.

You can select the species from the list provided (left), or use the search box to locate the right species more easily (right).

When you select the species you want, you'll find useful information about it, including:

- Common name and scientific name;
- General description of the species;
- Information on habitat, diet, breeding season;
- Distribution, known threats (to the species in question, or from this species to other species);
- Legal instruments (conventions, directives, etc. in which the species is included).
- The images uploaded by users and associated with each species will appear in a gallery at the end of each fact sheet.



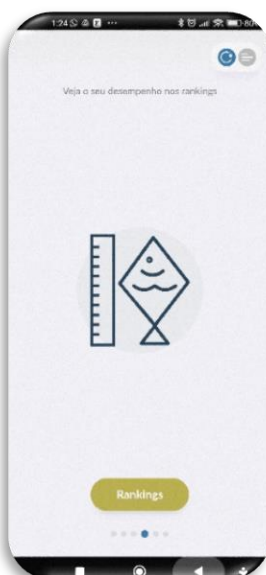
3.3. Fórum

- How the app works.

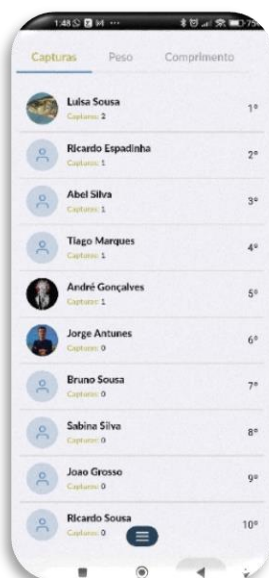
3.4. Interesting facts

3.5. Rankings

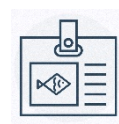


The Rankings menu will be updated as users update their catches.

You can view the ranking by number of catches, weight or length of the specimens caught.

By selecting each position in the ranking, you can view the gallery of catches for that user and the medals they have won.

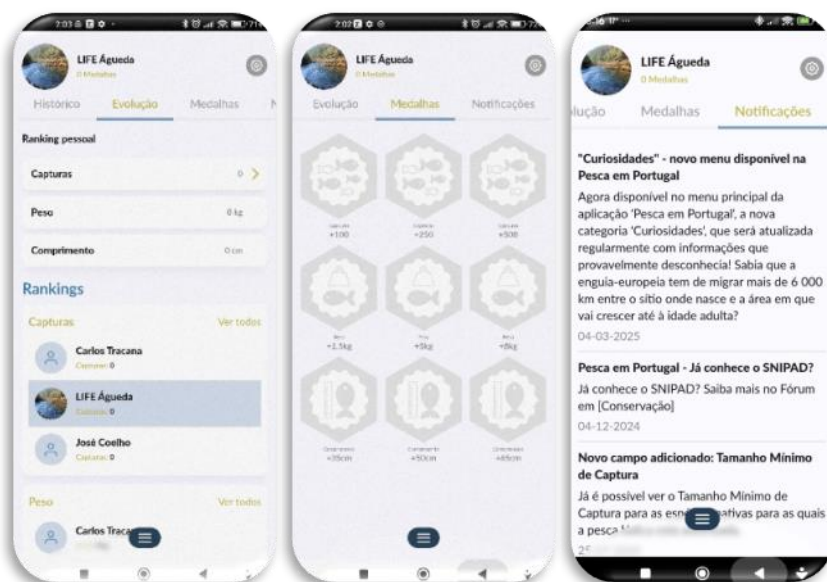
3.6. Profile



In the Profile menu, you can manage your account settings by selecting the symbol .

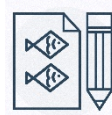
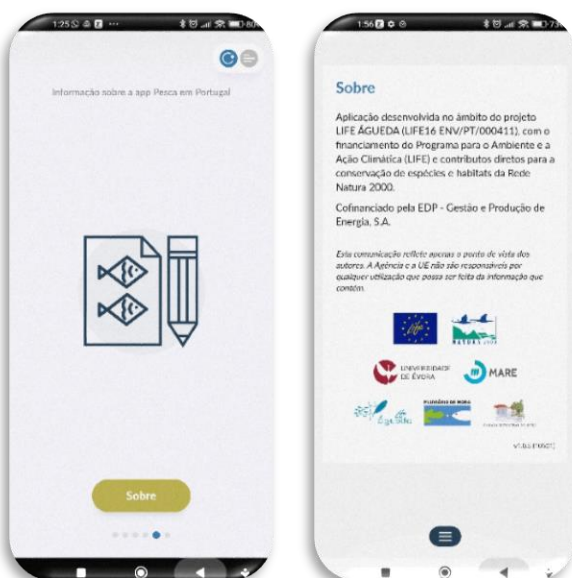
You can change your account image from your smartphone gallery, your username, password, and the language in which you prefer to open the application. You can also
